CEE began as the "CEE Saturday Success School" at the Phillis Wheatley
Center, 2000-2001. After the Phillis Wheatley Center closed, CEE operated at
Greenville Technical College, as the "CEE Saturday Success School" from
2001-2007, with outstanding results in academic achievement! CEE grew, adding
weekday Academics, Art, and Fitness Programs at Woodfield Park and Happy
Hearts Park of the Greenville County Recreation Commission, 2007. Aided
by the late Senator Ralph Anderson, the late Lottie Gibson, Greenville County
Council; and led by School Trustee and CEE Co-Founder, Leola Robinson,
CEE moved to 1191 Pendleton Street in 2007; with Coach Shakir Robinson as
Co-Founder/Director.
